PUBLICATION ETHICS

The journal upholds the highest standards of integrity, transparency, and accountability in research and publishing. All authors and reviewers are expected to adhere to the following ethical principles.

Core Ethical Principles

1. Integrity, transparency, accountability, and fairness in research and publishing must be maintained at all times.
2. Authors should show respect for persons, communities, cultures, and intellectual traditions throughout the research and publication process.

Authorship and Contributorship

3. Authorship requires substantial contributions to:
 - The conception or design of the work;
 - Drafting or critical revision of the content;
 - Final approval of the version to be published; and
 - Accountability for all aspects of the work. Use contributorship statements detailing each author's contributions.
4. The corresponding author must confirm that all co-authors approve the submission and the authorship order.
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11. Authors must cite primary sources where appropriate and accurately represent opposing or alternative views to maintain academic balance and integrity.

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
